

## **31 Days of Prayer**

As we enter into these 31 days of prayer, remember that prayer isn't just something else on your to do list, but it is an expression of an ever-deepening walk with God. The good thing about this call to prayer is that we are not talking about you spending hours in prayer. We're inviting you to invest ten to fifteen minutes a day to grow in prayer.

As we enter into these 31 days of prayer, I ask that you pray believing what you pray.

### **DAY 1: PRAY FOR GOD'S BLESSING ON YOUR WORK AND DAILY ACTIVITIES**

Lord, my highest good is to have you near. And how wonderful that You want me to come near to You, and that You delight to see my face and hear my voice. You want me to walk close to You all day long, resting my heart in the joy of who You are. Enable me to do this more and more.

How good of you, gracious Master, to call all Your children to serve as Your ambassadors in all that we do. How encouraging to know that every task I undertake as Your servant is Your work, even my small tasks. And that through prayer I can put You into all my daily activities, my employment, my marriage, my parenting, my spiritual walk and service, my free time and hobbies.

I commit all I do into Your hands and ask You to work in and through me. Give me grace to do each of my tasks for You, putting my whole heart into it. I depend on You for strength and wisdom all day long (Pray specifically about various things you'll be doing.)

Lord, You alone can give true significance to my work and activities. So I call on You to prosper all that I do. Let Your favor be upon me, and give permanence to what I do.

May I spread the fragrance of Christ to everyone my life touches day by day. Make me a gracious witness to those who don't know You, and a blessing to those who do.

### **DAY 2: PRAY FOR A LIFE OF ABIDING IN CHRIST**

Dear Father, what a privilege it is to abide in Christ, to dwell in Him, sharing His life as a branch shares the life of a vine. Thank You that He is my life.

Work in my heart to keep me abiding in Christ and filled with His Spirit day by day and moment by moment, by faith. Show me any hindrances to this in my life, and enable me to lay them aside. May His Word live in me richly, may I keep His commandments and abide in His love. May I so fully identify with Him as the Vine that people around will see in me His nature and His life. Lord, may this be especially true in my relationships and work, my marriage and family life.

I pray these things for the believers in my church and for other believers I know, especially \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. May the truths about abiding in Christ dawn on each of us in a fresh way.

**DAY 3: PRAY FOR PERSONAL NEEDS AND DESIRES, WITH THANKSGIVING**

Father, thank You that I can come to You with simple confidence, as a little child comes to his father or mother asking for what he needs. What a gracious generous Father You are!

I’m so grateful to You, for giving me life and breath and everything else. Every good and perfect gift comes from You, the Creator of all, more constant and unchanging than the sun and moon and stars. You are a sun and a shield, bringing light and warmth into my life and protecting me from harm. You’ve promised that I won’t lack anything good, that I’ll be safe and secure without fear of harm, if I seek You with a reverent heart, if I choose to trust You and go Your way instead of my own. More and more, make me this kind of person. Help me praise You often, for Your great goodness and tender love, and trust You more for all that I need. I come to you with my needs and desires. Draw me close to You, as I bring them to You day by day.

I pray about my need for encouragement, for release from inner stress, for greater love and wisdom in relating to others, especially my family, for knowing how to handle my insecurities, my anxieties, my anger, and for open doors in the future. I also pray for the needs of my parents, my brothers and sisters, my spouse and my marriage itself, my co-workers, and my neighbors. Lord, work in special ways.

Thank You, Lord, that You are so vastly wonderful, so utterly and completely delightful, that You can meet and overflow my deepest needs.

**DAY 4: PRAY FOR WISDOM AND GUIDANCE**

Dear Lord, how generous and powerful You are. You are able to listen to and help everyone in the world at the same time. What a wonderful Master to belong to! And thank You for revealing Your promises, commands and principles, so that Your Spirit can guide me in my praying and in my living.

I come to You now, asking You for greater wisdom and understanding in spiritual things. May I know what You want for me in the important decisions I’m facing. Give me on the spot wisdom and conversations when I need to make immediate decisions. In such decisions enable me to quickly commit them to You and trust You to help me say and do the right thing. Keep reminding me to do this, both at home and elsewhere so that I won’t depend on my own understanding.

Guide me in the long-range decisions I’m facing. He me seek the Holy Spirit’s enlightenment from Your Word. Help me as I weigh the possibilities, then conclude the right steps to take and the right time to take them. How much I need Your wisdom and guidance.

I pray now about some special decisions I have to make regarding \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. And guide other believers, near and far, in the decisions they are facing, especially \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. As our Shepherd, lead us in good paths, in paths that please You.

Again I praise You for Your wonderful wisdom and power and Your deep desire for my highest good, each day and throughout my whole life.

**Day 5: PRAY ABOUT YOUR TRIALS AND TESTINGS**

Father, I worship before You as the sovereign God, the Blessed Controller of all things. You always want what is best. You always know what is best, and You're always able to do what is best for Your obedient, trusting children. Nothing is too hard for You.

I rejoice that You promise to cause all things even things that are contrary to Your ideal will, to fit into a pattern for good for those who love You. And that this “good” includes becoming more like Jesus. And that somehow my prayers can make a difference in how things turn out and how much I benefit from all that comes my way. Thank You for Your promise. Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you and you will honor me.”

Give me grace, Lord, to trust You in each of my trials, large or small, to accept each one and cooperate with You so that I'll grow through it.

Guide me as I bring each problem area to You, my pressures, my finances, my uncertainties, my disappointments and failures (including my failures in relating to people). I trust You to work in my situations and give me practical wisdom in how to handle them. And even more, work in me. I lack power and I don't know what to do, but my eyes are on You.

Do these same things for \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ in their trials.

**DAY 6: PRAY FOR THE WORD OF GOD TO BUILD YOU UP**

Dear Lord, work in me so that I will always be alert and thankful when I pray, whether along or with others. So much depends on prayer. Don't let me be careless, or distracted, or on and off in my praying. May the same be true as I immerse myself in Your Word. I praise You for inspiring this marvelous book to build us up and set us free. How glad I am for the way it keeps me on track in my praying and my living.

May I look intently into Your Word day by day with a longing to know You better and do Your will at all times. May the Spirit unfold its truths to me; may He motivate me to meditate on it and apply it to my life. Make me diligent to hear and read it often, to make notes on it, to memorize it. Empower me to trust You and obey all Your commands. May Your Word be the joy and rejoicing of my heart.

Strengthen and renew me through Your Word, keeping us from sin, so that time after time we may know the refreshment that comes from your presence. Give us gracious boldness and power to share it with others, both believers and unbelievers.

I pray for Your rich blessing on Bible distribution, as well as on Bible preaching, teaching and reading in our area and beyond. Give special grace to those in countries where Bibles are scarce. May every child of Yours somehow get at least a New Testament and be nourished by its truths.

### **DAY 7: PRAY ABOUT LORDSHIP AND PROTECTION FROM EVIL**

Loving Father, faithful and full of power, I'm so grateful I can come to You with Confidence, for You keep Your promises and answer prayer. Not one single word of Your good promises has ever failed.

Lord, I submit myself to You, presenting my life and my desires as a living sacrifice. I acknowledge You as Lord of my desires, my plans, my successes and failures, my place in the world, my friendships, my popularity. You are Lord of my present and future relationships, health, money, possessions and human approval. How good it is to yield to You, knowing that You withhold no good thing from Your obedient children who trust You and call on You.

I choose to give up all rights to myself, take up my cross day by day, and follow You. Give me power to resist the devil. Give me grace not to let the world squeeze me into its mold, its desire to indulge, its desire to possess, its desire to impress. Instead, may Your Spirit remold my mind from within. I really need this, Father, so that I can know You better, delight in You more constantly, and experience Your good and perfect will for me.

Show Your mighty power; Lord, by keeping me following You closely. Do the same for my Christian friends and family members, especially the young ones. Deliver us from sin and from Satan. Do this especially for those who right now are toying with temptation or giving in to sin.

May we steer clear of sin, but don't let us isolate ourselves from the people of the world. Motivate us to reach out in love to them and to our relatives, friends, neighbors and associates as Your lights shining in a dark place.

### **DAY 8: PRAY FOR LOVE AND AGAINST HINDRANCES**

Lord of love, You are the one Source of perfect, unending love. Love that is sacrificial, impartial, and permanent! Work in me a growing love and affection for all people, and especially for all believers---a love like Yours: merciful, compassionate, ready to forgive, patient, considerate, deeply concerned about others' well being.

Show me if there's anything in my heart that would keep me from praying with Your love. Do you see grievances there? Anger? An unforgiving spirit? Resentment toward anyone in my past, or in my present? Envy or jealousy? Critical attitudes? Selfishness or pride? Anything else that hinders love? Show me. And give me grace to repent and ask You to forgive me. Help me take the initiative in restoring any broken or damaged relationships with others in my family, at work, or at my church.

May the Spirit flood my heart with your love, washing away any unloving attitudes. The may Your pure, warm love motivate me as I pray and flow through me toward every person my life touches day by day. I plead with You for this! And I believe You will do it.

And Lord, do these same things for all who partner with You in prayer, wherever they may be.

### **DAY 9: PRAY FOR STRENGTH AND WELL BEING**

Dear Father, I worship You as the One who made me, who intricately fashioned me as a unique person, weaving me with great skill in my mother’s womb. By your gracious, unlimited power You hold together all things---including each cell of my body.

Today by Your Spirit within me, I’m counting on You to bring to my whole being new strength and vitality---physical and emotional strength, spiritual and moral strength. Strength to do Your will.

And Lord, give me peace---shalom---wholeness and harmony and well-being. Bring emotional strength and joy day by day. In times of need give me grace to pour out my heart to You and cast on You all my anxieties and stresses and tensions. And then to fix my thoughts on You and rest in You. I pray these things for myself, Lord, and for others in need---including \_\_\_\_\_. Where there is weakness, may there be strength---Your strength. Where there is sickness, may there be healing. You are the One who heals us. “Man treats, God heals.” May your healing touch be on our bodies until the time comes when You choose to bring us total healing by calling us Home.

Day by day, may I rest my faith in Your tender love and Your infinite wisdom---Your deep, unsearchable wisdom. With quiet faith I trust You for health and healing, confident and expectant. But keep me from demanding, from clenching my fingers around what I think is best for me and others. May I honor You by affirming, “Our God whom we serve is able to deliver us, and He will deliver us. But even if He does not, we will trust Him.”

Most of all I pray for spiritual health. Keep me simply trusting You, yielding to You, and honoring You in all I am and all I do and think and say.

### **DAY 10: PRAY THAT MANY WILL TURN TO CHRIST**

Lord, I bow humbly before You. You are high and exalted, and I am so small and so human, so limited by time and space. You are holy and I fall so far short of Your glorious ideals. What amazing grace that You grant me access to you at all times, day and night!

Show me afresh Your deep love for the world---Your yearning that people trust Christ and live with You forever in Your eternal family. To think that my prayers can help fulfill Your longings!

Help me praise You often, for Your great goodness and tender love, and trust You more for all that I need. I come to you with my needs and desires. Draw me close to You, as I bring them to You day by day.

I desire to persevere in prayer day by day for my unsaved family members and friends, including especially \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_. Give me grace to pray for them often, and relate to them with greater love and helpfulness, and to tell them of Christ in winsome and timely ways. Make them intensely aware of their need for forgiveness. Convince them of Your love and draw them to Christ. Do the same for my friends and more distant relatives who don't know You, including \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. It seems, Lord, that there are so many barriers that keep people from You. Deliver those who think there are no absolutes, who believe that every viewpoint or lifestyle is okay as long as it seems right to them. Turn people from modern philosophies and Eastern religious practices---and from pursuing ideals of some sort (even "Christian" goodness or service), depending on their own efforts rather than on Christ. Defeat Satan as he blinds them to their need of the Cross. Open the eyes of thousands daily to the glorious light of the Good News of Christ. May many trust You for forgiveness in our community, our region, and beyond.

Show me how and where to focus my prayers. And motivate many around the world to pray faithfully that people will come to Christ.

***"To open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, so that they may receive forgiveness of sins...by faith in me."(Acts 26:18, NIV)***

### **DAY 11: PRAY FOR THE HOLY SPIRIT'S FULL MINISTRY IN YOU AND OTHERS.**

Thank you, my wonderful Father, the Source of every good and perfect gift, that You have sent Your Spirit to live in me---as a fountain of living water within me, springing up to refresh my heart and renew my mind. How sufficient His power is for my needs and the needs of all Your children! Thank You for Your promise of His ministry in our lives day by day, as we continue to ask and seek and knock.

I yield, Lord, to Your Spirit. I pray that He will fill me today and minister to me and through me. May He enlighten and nourish me through Your Word, strengthen my inner person, and fill my heart to overflowing with Your love. May He produce in me the very temperament of Jesus---His ways of thinking and behaving and reacting. Father, may this be especially true in my relationships---family and otherwise---in which I'm most prone to act and react in unloving ways.

I pray that the Spirit will empower me to witness with boldness. Wherever I may be, may He flow out from my inmost being as refreshing rivers of living water, meeting the needs of others. Help me depend on Him as I pray, counting on His presence within me, interceding for me and along with me. How much better He is than even my best and closest prayer partner!

I plead with You, Lord, for these same ministries of the Spirit in my prayer partners and in others who pray for Your work around the globe.

How much we need revival of prayer, so that Christ's great commission will be fulfilled in all the world. Lord bring one!

**Day 12: PRAY FOR GOD WORKING IN YOUR CHURCH**

Father, thank You for the privilege of fellowship with brothers and sisters in Your family. Some are such caring and encouraging Christians, helping fellow believers grow, reaching out to the lost, and serving in countless ways. Others need a greater interest in You and Your loving purposes. Work in me, making me faithful to pray regularly for them, in view of how dear they are to You.

Lord, may I, and each of us in our church, grow in your grace and in the knowledge of Your Son. In each service may we be worshipful and attentive, eager to learn and change our ways. And may we learn to use our spiritual gifts and serve as You lead.

Protect us from being deceived and led astray. Help us with our doubts, our stresses, our trials, and our relationships, especially in our families. Make our love for You and for one another increase and overflow. May those who have disputes or grievances resolve them quickly, before the end of the day. I pray these same things for our church's leaders and workers. In new ways make us a glory to Your name.

May we so live together in harmony, both in our families and our church, that our unity will be like a sweet perfume to You and to others, both believers and unbelievers.

**DAY 13: PRAY FOR SUNDAY SCHOOLS AND BIBLE STUDY GROUPS**

Gracious Father---High King of heaven, yet my Father!---You are seated in the throne room of the universe on a throne of grace, a throne of favor for the undeserving. What a privilege it is to come to your throne unafraid, with utter freedom and confidence, assured of Your glad welcome---"to run right into Your throne room and find Your arms opened wide!" (Kay Arthur). To know that I'll find mercy for my failures and grace for my every need! What good news that I don't need to be almost perfect to come boldly into Your presence! Your mercy lets me come with my mistakes, my sins, my needs---as long as I come honestly. Thank you that You are always ready to forgive, always eager to hear my voice and answer my prayers.

Thank you, Lord, for the dedicated Sunday school teachers and Bible study leaders in my church. May they enjoy bold access into Your presence day by day and refreshment from Your Word. Empower them, by Your Spirit, in their personal and family lives and in their teaching and leading. Help them realize that their work as Your servants is Your work. Enable them to surrender their service into Your hands and let You work in them and through them.

May the classes attract newcomers and draw them back week after week. Use these ministries to bring many to Christ and ground them in You and in Your Word. Use them to prepare people who, in turn, will become teachers and leaders, in both the near and distant future.

I pray these same requests for Sunday schools and Bible studies throughout our area---and beyond.

#### **DAY 14: PRAY FOR HOLINESS**

May we feed daily on Your holy Scriptures, letting You use them to cleanse our lives and remove our blemishes and wrinkles and defects.

I pray that Your people---and especially the Christians I know---will grow in holiness so that we will not dishonor Your name by compromised living. May we be blameless and contagious Christians, a good advertisement for the gospel.

I worship before you as the God of peace and well-being who is committed to making us holy. I count on You to do this day by day, giving us grace to cooperate with You. How I rejoice that You are faithful. You will continue Your work in us until the day when you bring us faultless into your glorious presence, with unspeakable joy.

#### **DAY 15: PRAY FOR THE CHURCH OF THE FUTURE, FOR THE GENERATION NOW GROWING UP**

Father, You are God throughout all generations, and You are deeply concerned about the temptations and moral pressures young people face today. I lift to You the young in my church, in my family and neighborhood, and beyond.

Draw them to Christ, and to true freedom through knowing and obeying Your Word. May they see You as good and desirable and loving; may they learn to love You with all their hearts and trust Your good plan for their futures. Give them godly role models and strong biblical convictions.

Give fathers and mothers great wisdom in bringing them up with loving discipline, Bible-centered instruction, and much prayer. And give children grace to love, respect, and obey their parents. May the parents be good examples in their walk with You and their love for each other. Work mightily to overcome problems in marriages and to keep parents together. And give special grace and help to families with only one parent.



Guide parents in their decisions about their children's education. Even when situations and educational opportunities are far from ideal---as with Samuel and Daniel, who were surrounded by evil---enable parents to lay strong spiritual foundations in each child's life.

Protect students from being misled by peer pressure and by the world's ways of thinking and living.

Encourage and strengthen Christian teachers in their important work. And I pray for all who minister to children, students, and families. May Your Spirit deeply touch many lives through them. I especially lift up \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_, asking for wisdom, strength, and encouragement for them.

### **DAY 16: PRAY FOR GRACE TO BE DILIGENT IN PRAYER**

It's a pleasure, Lord, to come into Your presence, and be still before You, and rest in Your love. How good it is to worship You and commune with You. And what strength and refreshment come from warm fellowship with You!

But don't let me forget that prayer is more than this. Give me grace to work diligently in prayer for others. And as You lead, to wrestle earnestly in prayer for others. And as You lead, to wrestle earnestly in prayer on their behalf. Put special burdens on my heart, enable me to pour out my heart, and enable me to pour out my heart for You to fulfill Your purposes.

Father, Your great desire is for all Your children to be both mature and effective. Do this for me, and for those in my church. Do it for fellow believers throughout our area. And our country. Do it for all believers.

Thank You for Your Spirit and the power He gives me to serve You---and others---through prayer.

Thank You for the way praise refreshes and strengthens me to work hard in prayer, and the way it stimulates my faith and help assure answers.

Greatly use those who are seeking to rally Your people to pray. Raise up many who will pray faithfully, pleading with You to work mightily in all the world.

### **DAY 17: PRAY FOR GOD'S PURIFYING WORK**

Holy Father, Holy Son, Holy Spirit---God of awesome holiness and purity, of power and righteous judgment! I stand in awe of You, in holy dread of disobeying You, for You are a blazing, purifying fire. I also thank You that You are eager to consume everything that detracts from my well-being, my relationships, and my nearness to You.

“Who of us can dwell with the consuming fire? He who walks righteously...” Lord, I long to live righteously every day, all day long. How much I need Your purifying presence to reprove me and purge my life of all that grieves You. Many of Your people likewise need refining fires to reveal and burn out sin. Bring release from the things that bind us---compromise, complacency, tolerance of sin, materialism, love of power, infighting, gossip, lack of spiritual depth. Give each of us a spirit of repentance and power to live our lives with reverent fear of You. Implant deep within me a hatred for sin and an enduring longing to be more like You.

Thank You, Father, that You discipline me because You want to adorn my character with the purity and beauty of Christ. Enable me to trust Your loving intentions and not to resist You. When You as a refiner of silver, use painful, fiery trials to bring the scum to the top in my life, give me grace to cooperate with You in removing it rather than just stirring it back in.

I praise You that You are full of compassion and that the outcome of Your purifying work is more than worth all You let us go through.

#### **DAY 18: PRAY FOR LOVE IN THE CHURCH**

May we constantly show the fragrant love of Christ to one another, as we look forward to being together for all eternity. May the world see Your love in our lives, and may this draw many to You.
